## **INTRODUCTION**

The Complainant contacted the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario (the College) to express concerns about the Respondent's medical record-keeping.

## **COMMITTEE'S DECISION**

The Committee considered this matter at its meeting of January 19, 2026. The Committee required the Respondent to appear before a Panel of the Committee to be cautioned with respect to his repeated failure to follow the College's policy, *Medical Records Documentation*, including not keeping accurate, complete, and comprehensive records, and not utilizing templates appropriately.

The Committee also accepted an undertaking from the Respondent.

## **COMMITTEE'S ANALYSIS**

These included the use of templates without editing to ensure they reflect the patient encounter, various other inaccuracies such as incorrect medications or doses, histories, and symptoms, and a lack of organization.

The Committee identified serious deficiencies in the Respondent's medical record-keeping. These included the use of templates without editing to ensure they reflected the patient encounter; various other inaccuracies, such as incorrect medications or doses, histories, and symptoms; and a lack of organization. The Committee reminded the Respondent that appropriate medical record-keeping is essential to ensuring safe and appropriate patient care and is a professional obligation.

The Committee's concerns were heightened by the Respondent's prior history with the College, which included issues related to professionalism, record-keeping, and adherence to College policy.
