

**SUMMARY of the Decision of the Inquiries, Complaints and Reports Committee

INTRODUCTION

The College received information raising concerns about the Respondent's surgical practice. Subsequently, the Committee approved the Registrar's appointment of investigators to conduct a broad review of the Respondent's practice.

COMMITTEE'S DECISION

The Committee considered this matter at its meeting of June 20, 2025. The Committee required the Respondent to complete a specified continuing remediation and education program (SCERP) consisting of education, clinical supervision, and reassessment.

COMMITTEE'S ANALYSIS

As part of this investigation, the Committee considered the reports of two external reviewers.

The first external reviewer, a general surgeon, was retained by the Respondent's former employer to review seven of the Respondent's patient charts, interview the Respondent and the Respondent's colleagues, and submit written reports.

The second external reviewer, a general surgeon, was retained by the Respondent's legal counsel to review the same seven charts and submit written reports.

While the external reviewers disagreed on several aspects of the Respondent's care of patients in the seven charts reviewed, they agreed that the Respondent would benefit from remediation in medical record-keeping, professionalism, and surgical judgment. The Committee agreed with the conclusions of the external reviewers that the Respondent required remediation and supervision in relation to these areas of practice.

The Committee also noted its concern that the Respondent demonstrated a lack of willingness to entertain constructive feedback regarding his practice.

Because the Respondent did not take the opportunity to undertake a program of self-study through an undertaking, and because the Committee's concerns were significant, the Committee required the Respondent to complete a specified continuing education

or remediation program to ensure that the Respondent undergoes necessary remediation and supervision.
