

**SUMMARY of the Decision of the Inquiries, Complaints and Reports Committee

**INTRODUCTION**

The College received a mandatory report from the hospital where the Respondent previously held privileges, outlining that an external review into the Respondent's clinical practice concluded that the Respondent did not always meet a reasonable standard of care, and that while the Respondent did not lack knowledge, his care displayed a lack of skill or judgement at times, which may have exposed his patients to harm. Subsequently, the Committee approved the Registrar's appointment of investigators to conduct a review of the Respondent's practice.

**COMMITTEE'S DECISION**

An Obstetrics and Gynecology Panel of the Committee considered this matter at its meeting of November 28, 2023. The Committee required the Respondent to appear before a Panel of the Committee to be cautioned with respect to effective communication and collaboration with the clinical team and the appropriate restratification of high and low-risk pregnancies. The Committee also accepted an undertaking from the Respondent.

**COMMITTEE'S ANALYSIS**

The Committee concluded that specific, focused remediation intervention is necessary to address the identified concerns. In the Committee's view, the Respondent's lapses in skill or judgment noted in the external review report were serious enough to warrant a caution as outlined above in addition to the Respondent's undertaking.

This is a summary of the Committee's decision as it relates to the caution disposition.
