

QA SCERPS and Public Register

On October 11, 2018, the Quality Assurance Committee (“QAC”) required general family medicine physician, Dr. Augustine Opara, to complete a specified continuing education and remediation program (“SCERP”). The SCERP requires Dr. Opara to:

- Attend and provide proof of successful completion of the following course:
 - OCFP Course – Practising Wisely
 - University of Toronto Medical Records Course
 - OntarioMD EMR Practice Enhancement Program
 - Foundation for Medical Practice Education SGPB or PBIL Program (or equivalent)
- Review the following policies, guidelines or tools with reference to how each is applicable to family medicine:
 - Choosing Wisely – Family Medicine
 - MOHLTC Guidelines for HIV Counseling and Testing
 - Section 88 of the 2018 Canadian Journal of Diabetes Guidelines: Pharmacologic Glycemic Management of Type 2 Diabetes in Adults
 - CPSO Medical Records Policy
- Undergo a reassessment with an assessor selected by the College, approximately 12 months following the completion of the Education Plan.
