

**SUMMARY of the Decision of the Inquiries, Complaints and Reports Committee

INTRODUCTION

The College received information raising concerns about the Respondent's cooperation with the Ontario College of Pharmacists (OCP). Subsequently, the Committee approved the Registrar's appointment of investigators to investigate the issue.

COMMITTEE'S DECISION

A Family Practice Panel of the Committee considered this matter at its meeting of June 1, 2023. The Committee required the Respondent to appear before a Panel of the Committee to be cautioned with respect to cooperating with a regulatory body.

COMMITTEE'S ANALYSIS

The OCP provided the College with a complete investigative record that demonstrated that they tried several times to obtain information from the Respondent regarding the investigation but were unsuccessful. The Respondent stated that he cooperated with the OCP, but he did not provide any documentation to support his statement, despite the College's request for this information.

Upon review of the available material, the Committee found the Respondent's conduct in regard to this matter to be concerning. It appeared that the Respondent did not cooperate with the OCP's efforts to obtain information from him in the course of an investigation.

The Committee would have considered referring this matter to the Ontario Physicians and Surgeons Discipline Tribunal (OPSDT or the Discipline Tribunal) if the Respondent held a certificate of membership with the College.

Instead of referring this matter to the Discipline Tribunal, the Committee decided to require the Respondent to appear before a panel of the Committee to be cautioned, as noted above. The information from this investigation will be available in any contested hearing about the Respondent's reinstatement.
