

UNDERTAKING, ACKNOWLEDGEMENT AND CONSENT
(“Undertaking”)

of

DR. ALAN HOWARD LAITY
(“Dr. Laity”)

to

COLLEGE OF PHYSICIANS AND SURGEONS OF ONTARIO
(the “College”)

PREAMBLE

In this Undertaking:

“Discipline Committee” means the Discipline Committee of the College;

“ICR Committee” means the Inquiries, Complaints and Reports Committee of the College;

“OHIP” means the Ontario Health Insurance Plan;

“Public Register” means the College’s register that is available to the public.

- I, **Dr. Laity**, certificate of registration number **66399**, received my certificate of registration authorizing independent practice in family medicine only on July 1, 1993. I resigned from membership with the College on June 26, 2017.
- I, **Dr. Laity**, have not, since June 26, 2017, in any jurisdiction, practiced medicine, been registered as a physician, had any applications pending for registration as a physician, or applied or re-applied for registration as a physician.
- I, **Dr. Laity**, acknowledge that the College referred allegations of professional misconduct to the Discipline Committee on July 26, 2017.

UNDERTAKING, ACKNOWLEDGEMENT AND CONSENT

- I, **Dr. Laity**, hereby undertake not to apply or re-apply for registration as a physician to practise medicine in Ontario or any other jurisdiction after the day I execute this undertaking (the “Effective Date”).
- I, **Dr. Laity**, acknowledge that in the event that the College should become aware that I am in breach of this Undertaking including, but not limited to, becoming aware that I have either applied, re-applied or attempted to apply or re-apply for registration as a physician or for a certificate of registration, or equivalent, to practise medicine in any jurisdiction

after the Effective Date, the College shall, in its sole discretion, have the right to proceed with a disciplinary proceeding on the basis of a breach of this Undertaking.

I, **Dr. Laity**, hereby agree to bear the risk of any prejudice that the passage of time might cause to my ability to make full answer and defence, and waive the right to seek any remedy on the basis of the passage of time, should the College proceed with any allegations that may arise as a result of a breach of this Undertaking.

I, **Dr. Laity**, undertake to abide by the College's Policy on Practice Management Considerations for Physicians Who Cease to Practise, Take an Extended Leave of Absence or Close Their Practice Due to Relocation, a copy of which is attached hereto as Appendix "A".

I, **Dr. Laity**, undertake that upon signing this Undertaking, I shall forward a request to the General Manager of OHIP that my billing number be deactivated for services rendered after June 26, 2017.

I, **Dr. Laity**, acknowledge that all appendices attached to or referred to in this Undertaking form part of this Undertaking.

I, **Dr. Laity**, acknowledge and undertake that I shall be solely responsible for payment of all fees, costs, charges, expenses, etc., if any, arising from the implementation of any of the provisions of this Undertaking.

I, **Dr. Laity**, acknowledge and confirm that I have read and understand the provisions of this Undertaking and that I have obtained independent legal counsel in reviewing and executing this Undertaking, or have waived my right to do so.

I, **Dr. Laity**, give my irrevocable consent to the College to make appropriate enquiries of OHIP and/or any person who or institution that may have relevant information, in order for the College to monitor my compliance with the provisions of this Undertaking.

I, **Dr. Laity**, acknowledge that I have executed the OHIP consent form, attached hereto as Appendix "B" and that the consent forms part of this Undertaking.

Public Register

(a) I, **Dr. Laity**, consent to this Undertaking being posted on the Public Register.

(b) I, **Dr. Laity**, acknowledge that, in addition to this Undertaking being posted in accordance with section 0(a) above, the following summary shall be posted on the Public Register during the time period that this Undertaking remains in effect:

Dr. Laity resigned his certificate of registration in June 2017. Dr. Laity was referred to the Discipline Committee on allegations of professional misconduct in July 2017. In the face of these allegations, Dr. Laity has agreed never to apply or reapply for registration as a physician in Ontario or any other jurisdiction.
